## ❖ 神对死的定义 God's definition of death

- 只是分别善恶树上的果子，你不可吃，因为你吃的日子必定死。(创世记 2:17)
- 亚当共活了九百三十岁就死了。(创世记 5:5)
- but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for on the day that you eat from it you will certainly die. (Genesis 2:17)
- So all the days that Adam lived were 930 years, and he died. (Genesis 5:5)

- 你们从前在过犯，和未受割礼的肉体中死了。(歌罗西书 2:13)
- 何况基督借着永远的灵，将自己无瑕无疵献给神，他的血岂不更能洗净你们的心。(原文作良心) 除去你们的死行，使你们事奉那永生神吗？(来9:14)
- When **you were dead in your sins** and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, (Colossians 2:13)
- How much rather shall the blood of the Christ, who by the eternal Spirit offered himself spotless to God, purify your conscience from **dead works** to worship [the] living God? (Hebrews 9:14)

- 耶稣说了这话，随后对他们说，我们的朋友拉撒路睡了，我去叫醒他。(约翰福音 11:11)
- 论到睡了的人，我们不愿意弟兄们不知道，恐怕你们忧伤，像那些没有指望的人一样。我们若信耶稣死而复活了，那已经在耶稣里睡了的人，神也必将他与耶稣一同带来。(帖撒罗尼迦前书 4:13-14)
- This He said, and after this He said to them, “Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep; but I am going so that I may awaken him from sleep.” (John 11:11)
- But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers *and sisters*, about those who are asleep, so that you will not grieve as indeed the rest of *mankind do*, who have no hope. <sup>14</sup> For if we believe that Jesus died and rose *from the dead*, so also God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep through Jesus. (1 Thessalonians 4:13-14)

- 叫人活着的乃是灵，肉体是无益的。我对你们所说的话，就是灵，就是生命。(约翰福音 6:63)
- 愿主与你的灵同在，(提摩太后书 4:22)
- **It is the Spirit who gives life** (GK 'make alive'); the flesh provides no benefit; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit, and are life. (John 6:63)
- The Lord be with your spirit. (2 Timothy 4:22)

## ❖ 靠神的话活着 Man lives by God's Word

- 耶稣却回答说，经上記着说，**人活着，不是单靠食物，乃是靠神口里所出的一切话。**（马太福音 4:4）
- But He answered and said, **“It is written: ‘MAN SHALL NOT LIVE ON BREAD ALONE, BUT ON EVERY WORD THAT COMES OUT OF THE MOUTH OF GOD.’”** (Matthew 4:4)

- 你也要纪念耶和华你的神在旷野引导你这四十年，是要苦炼你，试验你，要知道你心内如何，肯守他的诫命不肯。他苦炼你，任你饥饿，将你和你列祖所不认识的吗哪赐给你吃，使你知道，人活着不是单靠食物，乃是靠耶和华口里所出的一切话。(申命记 8:2-3)
- And you shall remember all the way which the LORD your God has led you in the wilderness these forty years, in order to humble you, putting you to the test, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not.  
<sup>3</sup> And He humbled you and let you go hungry, and fed you with the manna which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, in order to make you understand that man shall not live on bread alone, but man shall live on everything that comes out of the mouth of the LORD. (Deuteronomy 8:2-3)

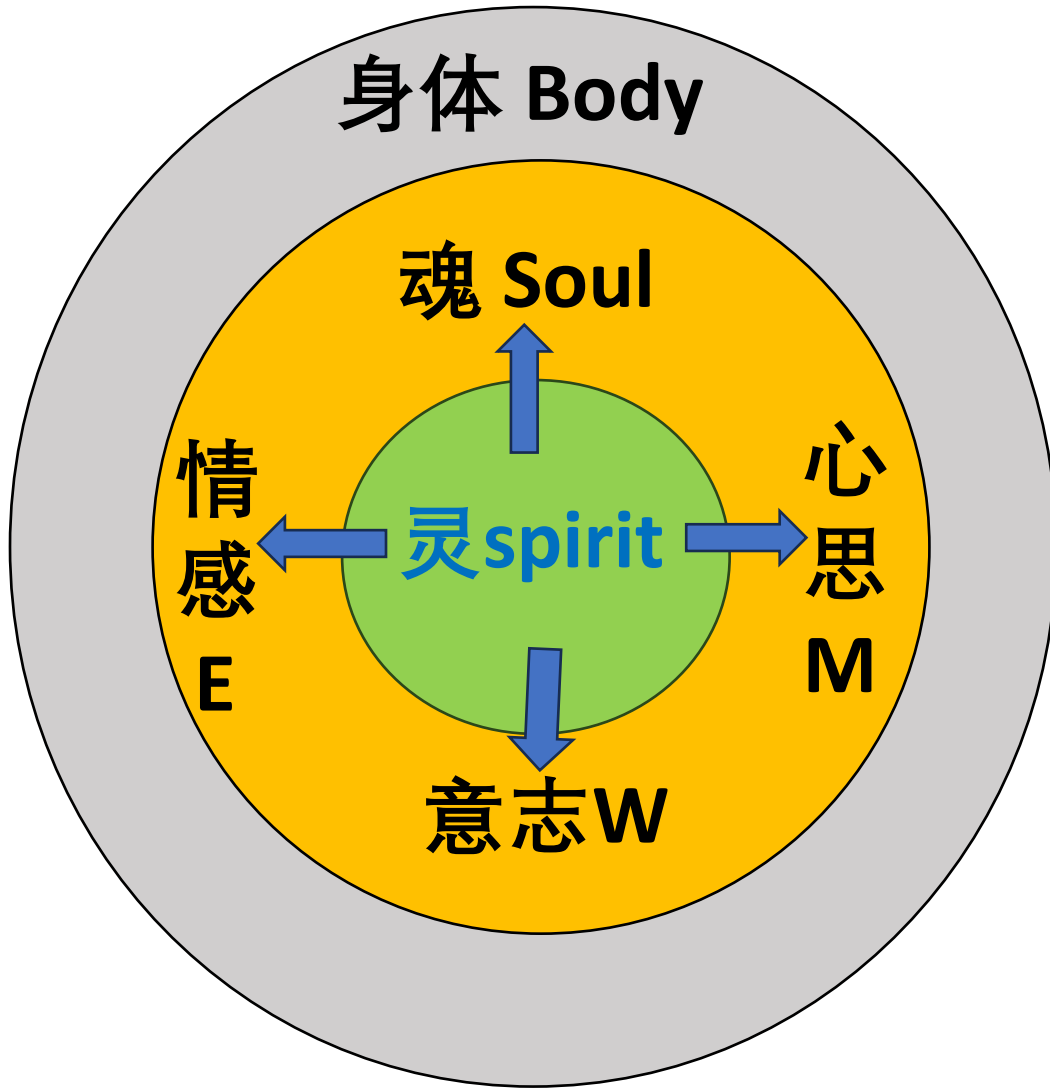
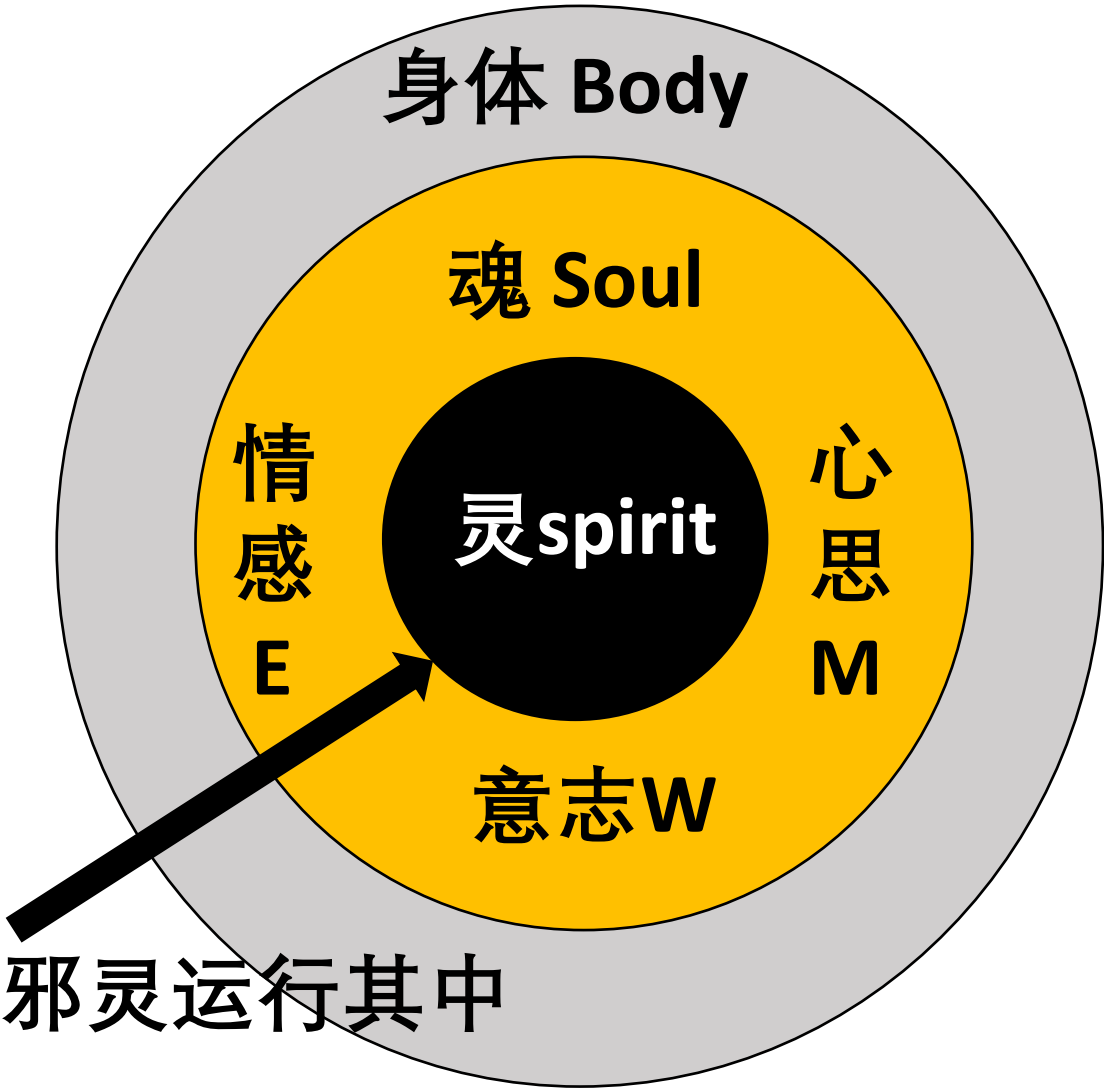

- Therefore, rid *yourselves* of all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander, <sup>2</sup> and like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation, <sup>3</sup> if you have tasted the kindness of the Lord.(1 Peter 2:1-2)
